## About Guru Jambheshwar Ji Maharaj

Guru Jambheshwar Ji Maharaj was a saint and great environmentalist of 15th century. Amongst all the saints of the 15th century, Guru Jambheshwar Ji was unique in preaching about the conservation of biodiversity to his followers. He also included the same in his 29 commandments. Thus, Guru Jambheshwar Ji was not only a religious 'GURU' but a great ecologist and environmentalist, many centuries ahead of the scientists. He was born in 1451 A.D. (Samvat 1508) on 8th day of dark half of the Lunar month Bhadrapad on Janamashtami, in a village Pipasar situated in the revenue jurisdiction of Nagur district of Rajasthan, India. He adopted the life of an ascetic teacher in 1484 AD and started living on the Samrathal, sand Dhora hill of Mukam village situated in Nokha tehsil of Bikaner district of Rajasthan. He enshrined in his followers compassion towards nature and protection of life as the supreme religious goal. He founded the Bishnoi sect in 1485 AD on eighth day of the black fortnight of the month of Kartika of the year 1542 of the Vikrami Era at Samrathal Dhora and prescribed 29 commandments dealing with various aspects of life. He spent the remaining 51 years of his life in spreading his great vision. He expounded his religious philosophy and the essence of these principles in the form of verses. These spiritual verses have a vigour of their own, vibrant, passionate and sincere. These are distinguished by their vivid and conversational style and moral exhortation. Guru Ji achieved Nirvana in 1536 in village Lalasar District Bikaner, Rajasthan. Among the 29 commandments laid down by Guru Jambheshwar Ji, eight commandments have been prescribed to preserve biodiversity and encourage good animal husbandry. Seven commandments provide directions for healthy social behavior. Ten Commandments are directed towards personal hygiene and maintaining good basic health. Four commandments provide guidelines for worshipping God daily and always remember that God is omnipresent. Guru Jambheshwar Ji had occupied a unique place in the Bhakti movement. Though his area of activity had been mainly the desert land of Thar, yet he had been touring other places too. During these extensive tours he has been spreading the message within and outside the country;

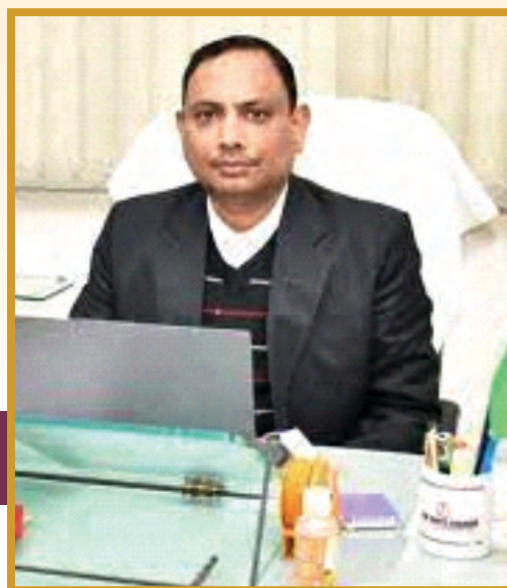

- ❖ Guru Jambheshwar University of Science & Technology, Hisar (formerly Guru Jambheshwar University) is a State University established in **1995**.
- ❖ The university focuses on studies and research in emerging areas of higher education, including technology, pharmacy, environmental studies, non-conventional sources of energy, and management studies.
- ❖ It is named after Guru Jambheshwar Ji Maharaj, a saint environmentalist of the 15th century.
- ❖ The university campus is located in **Hisar**, spread over **372 acres** with picturesque landscapes and various buildings.
- ❖ It has been recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC) and is accredited with an '**A+**' **Grade** by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC).
- ❖ The university has achieved notable rankings, including **49th** in the '**Pharmacy**' category and **101-150th** in the overall university category in **NIRF-2023**.
- ❖ It has also been ranked in the Times Higher Education World University ranking, Times Higher Education Emerging Economies University Rankings, and **UI Green Matric World University Rankings**.
- ❖ The university is known for its research initiatives, interdisciplinary collaboration, and publications in reputed journals.
- ❖ Around 3793 research papers have been published by the faculty in peer reviewed journals of repute which are listed in SCOPUS with about 75803 citations.
- ❖ The h-index of the University was 112 in May 2023. This is the highest h-index of any University in the State of Haryana. Average Paper Citation is 20.08 which is also 23 highest in the region.
- ❖ The university has received grants and recognition from various government bodies, including RUSA, MHRD, and the Social Justice and Empowerment Department of the Government of Haryana.

## Focus on Research

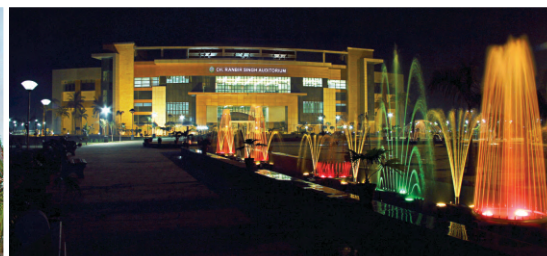
- ❖ The University has a dedicated team of well qualified faculty members, engaged in teaching and research activities. The total number of papers published by the faculty in peer reviewed journals of national and international repute since 2009-10 is 2861.
- ❖ Besides this, the faculty members have published 48 text books including 17 edited books and contributed 76 chapters in books since 2009-10.
- ❖ The h-index of the University has also gone up to 112 at present from 17 in 2009-10 with more than 3793 publications and over 75803 citations as per Scopus Database. On the basis of h-index, the University has been sanctioned PURSE grant of Rs. 10.25 crores for research in the year 2016.
- ❖ Faculty members mobilized and completed projects worth more than Rs.2.5 crores during last 4 years. Eight departments of the university have been awarded the SAPDRS projects by UGC and the same has been added to their stature and infrastructure.
- ❖ In addition to this, Department of Bio & Nano Technology is being provided HRD grant for M.Sc. Biotechnology course by the Department of Biotechnology, Govt. of India since 2000, Bioinformatics Facility (BIF) grant by Department of Biotechnology, Govt. of India since 2006, HRD grant for M.Tech. Nano Science & Technology by Ministry of Science & Technology Govt. of India under Nano Mission program. DST-FIST grants have been awarded to Departments of Bio & Nano Technology, Pharmaceutical Science, Chemistry and Physics.
- ❖ The University has been funded thrice by TEQIP Scheme by World Bank, Board of Research In Nuclear Science (Department of Atomic Energy) and other agencies like MHRD, MHFW, Ministry of Defence (DRDO), Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, National Board for Higher Mathematics, Distance Education Council, Ministry of Women and Child Welfare, Department of Scheduled Castes, Haryana.
- ❖ Further, International collaborative project includes sponsorships by DRDO, DST, Govt. of India and Ministry of Science & Technology, Thailand which is currently implemented by this university jointly with Asian Institute of Technology, Bangkok, Thailand. The MoU with INFLIBNET for electronic dissemination of Ph.D. thesis through open access in Shodhganga is in place.



# State of the Art Infrastructure & Facilities

## CH. RANBIR SINGH AUDITORIUM

Ch. Ranbir Singh Auditorium forms the main component of architectural composition of the Central core of University Campus. The main hall is large enough for an audience of over 1800 persons and additional facilities of three Seminar Halls on the ground floor, one with a capacity of 250 persons and other two with a capacity of 125 persons each. This building is intended for convocations, conferences, seminars, workshops, concerts, ballets, film shows, plays and other stage performances etc. of national & international level. **Ch. Ranbir Singh Auditorium building is one of the beautiful and State-of-the-Art Auditoriums in India and it has been awarded by National Planning Commission of India (Construction Industry Development Council Vishwakarma Awards 2014) under best construction project at National level. This Auditorium building has also been awarded by National Planning Commission of India (Construction Industry Development Council Vishwakarma Awards 2015) under best maintained structures at National level.**



## PT. DEENDAYAL UPADHYAYA COMPUTER & INFORMATICS CENTRE (PDUCIC)

The Pt. Deendayal Upadhyaya Computer & Informatics Centre (PDUCIC) is established with the aim to act as a central facility to meet the computing requirements of all the students, research scholars, staff, and faculty of the University. The center is equipped with 225 desktop computers of the latest configuration along with 04 dedicated servers to cater the ICT activities of the University. The centre also hosts the information centric website of University for students/stakeholders/readers for the latest information about the University. Centre also hosts an independent website for Distance Education Department for related latest information. Further, the centre provides free internet facility to the University students. All the computers are connected on 1G Network and provides internet facility with 100 Mbps speed through dedicated leased line. Many online tests of national level for admissions, jobs are also conducted in PDUCIC with the help of testing agencies. Additionally, the centre also conducts the online tests for the training and placements of students.



From its very inception, the PDUCIC has effectively been performing task of building up data processing capabilities of many branches of the University and playing a vital role in imparting intensive training time to time to the staff of the University. In addition, there is a full-fledged language lab prepared with Wordsworth software to enhance the language skills and personality development of students.



## DR. BHIM RAO AMBEDKAR LIBRARY

The University Library came into existence in 1996 and is housed in a circular designed three-storey large building. It is named after the Great Indian Jurist, Economist, Politician and Social Reformer Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar. The seating capacity of the University Library is 400 seats. The library runs in two shifts i.e., 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. and 11:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M. and remains open on Saturdays and Sundays also. The timing of Night Reading Hall is 8:00 A.M. to 12:00 Midnight, however during examination, it remains open round the clock.



Realizing the crucial role of up-to-date information services for conducting high level R&D activities, the library since its inception has been in the continuous process of building and updating a standardized collection with latest publication. In these endeavors, by the end of March 2022, the Library has a collection of 122468 books and 5850 bound volumes of Journals. For getting the information about individual Library Account Status and availability of books is provided through Web-OPAC. The library has subscribed 281 Printed Indian Journals and subscribed 41 Magazines and 20 Newspapers. The library has always been in forefront in the application of latest information and communication technology, whenever available. To make it accomplish, the library in its electronic repository, has the access of about 8000 e-journals from 13 Publishers and 5 Databases.

The library has one Research Database Lab for the Research Scholars and Faculty Members. This lab is equipped with state-of-the-art facilities. Moreover, the University has signed MOU with INFLIBNET for Shodhganga Repository and so far, 394 theses have been uploaded. The library recorded 97104 visitors during the period January 2020 to March 2022. During this period total issue for home lending were 39758 books and total 94513 books were consulted by the members of the library.



## HOSTELS

There are nine hostels (four for boys, four for girls and one for working women) which can accommodate more than 2000 students. All the hostels are fully equipped with basic amenities like commercial RO with UV & ozonator, Water coolers, LED TV, electric geysers, telephone facilities, insect killers, adequate playgrounds and other recreational facilities like chessboards, carom boards, badminton etc. The hostels have Ambulance facility for students residing in hostels 24x7 for any medical emergencies. There is also internet and Wi-Fi facilities for the students in hostels. The lawns around the hostel are developed aesthetically to provide refreshing view to the residents. The girls hostel complex in which all the girl hostels come under a common boundary wall having Air-conditioned Cyber Cafe, general store, beauty parlour shop, confectionary shop and photostat shop. Each girls hostel and working women hostel is provided with sanitary pad vending machine & sanitary pad incinerator. The CCTV cameras have been installed at various places for security purpose. Further, each hostel has a common room where newspapers and latest magazines are available to the students and gym equipped with tread mills, exercise cycle & abdominal exerciser, etc.





Healthy menu is provided by the contractor on the reasonable rates and menu items & quality check is done randomly by the Mess Committees, Wardens, Coordinators, Deputy Chief Wardens and the Chief Wardens. Hostel accommodation will be provided according to latest Govt. COVID-19 Guidelines and hostel rules. The prospective hostellers are also required to submit medical fitness certificate at the time of admission. The hostel residents are governed by the terms and conditions as contained in the University Hostel Regulations. The university administration with the very energetic and dedicated team of hostel administrations ensures a better quality of life for all the hostel residents.

## SPORTS FACILITY

The Directorate of Sports was established and working since 1996 in the University. The games in the University are Football, Cricket, Lawn Tennis, Basketball, Handball, Volleyball, Badminton, Table Tennis, Yoga, Karate, Kabaddi, Weight Lifting and Shooting Range as well as an Athletic Track of 400 Meters. In addition, there are two Lawn Tennis court with Practice wall. One high tech Gym is established in the Multipurpose Hall in the premises of the Directorate of Sports. For participation in various games, the University provides Track Suit, playing kit & Shoes to all the participants, provide to the coaches and the Team Manager who accompany with the team. Our university students have participated in more than 50 Inter University tournaments and achieved various positions. To motivate the players the Directorate of Sports awarded the cash prize of Rs. 10.00 Lacs to the position holders during the year 2019-2020.



## DR. A.P.J. ABDUL KALAM CENTRAL INSTRUMENTATION LABORATORY (CIL)

The Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Central Instrumentation Laboratory (CIL) is established for the students, research scholars and teachers of the University who are actively engaged in R&D activities in the emerging areas of Science, Technology & Engineering. Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Innovation & Incubation Centre (PDUIIC) was established in Guru Jambheshwar University of Science & Technology, Hisar, Haryana in 2018 and was formally Digitally Launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister Sh. Narendra Modi Ji on 3rd February, 2019 from Sher-e-Kashmir International Convention Centre, Srinagar under the scheme of RUSA 2.0, MHRD, Government of India, New Delhi simultaneously in Twenty six States, one Union Territory and Fifty one aspirational districts of the entire nation with budget outlay of Fifteen Crores.

PDUIIC aims to become a hub of Innovative and Startup activities in the state of Haryana and will put sincere efforts in realizing the slogan of "Make in India" of Central Government. It facilitates the dream of prospective Young Innovators from conceiving the idea to technological development/inventions. It serves to coordinate and promote Incubation and Innovation driven activities for budding entrepreneurs. It provides a platform to the Young Innovators for achieving their goal towards self-realization by strengthening Startups in thematic areas of National concern. It shares its resources including space and infrastructure, access to business support services, mentoring, training programs to enhance the skills of entrepreneurs and seed funds. The scope of support is broad-based, and covers technologies developed wholly at the Institute or partly through collaborations elsewhere, as well as external startups with which members are associated as consultants or mentors.



## UNIVERSITY HEALTH CENTRE

- ❖ UHC is a primary health centre established in 1997 for medical needs of students, staff and their family members.
- ❖ It is spacious enough to accommodate three doctors cabins for OPD, one Dental clinic, one observation room with three beds facility, minor O.T, one dispensing room, one laboratory and one medicine store.
- ❖ It is well equipped with ECG machine, nebulizer, autoclave, foetal monitor, autoanalyser, Hematology analyser, Oxygen concentrator etc.
- ❖ Dental clinic is very well equipped with modern equipment like RVG, Apex locator, scaler etc.
- ❖ The staff of Health Centre includes one Senior Medical Officer, four Medical Officers, one Dental Surgeon, one Chief Pharmacy Officer, two Staff Nurses, one Matron, two Pharmacists, one Lab Technician, one Technician Officer and two Lab Attendants.



#### Various facilities provided at health Centre are as follows:

- ❖ Medical aid for all common ailments with routine blood, urine and stool tests. Patients requiring only day care are managed here.
- ❖ Health Centre provides medical care during the cultural and sports events at the event site.
- ❖ Health Centre runs the Medical Reimbursement cell which deals with medical reimbursement cases as per Haryana re-imbusement policy.
- ❖ Health Centre fully participates in Children vaccination programs along with the Civil hospital staff. It has also been part of national pulse polio campaign from time to time.
- ❖ Health camps and talks are also conducted by Health Centre on regular basis. Health Centre remains open continuously from 7:30 am to 6.00 pm. After 6.00 pm two ambulances parked in girls and boys hostel take the patients to the approved hospitals for management.
- ❖ Health Centre is a day care Centre. For indoor services all the hospitals on Govt. panel are on university panel (<http://haryanahealth.nic.in/Empanelment.html>) for reimbursement purposes.

### NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

The Moto of the National Service Scheme (NSS) is "Not Me, But You". This expresses the essence of democratic living and upholds the need for selfless services to appreciate the other person's point of view. It shows consideration for fellow human being. It underlines that the welfare of individual is ultimately dependent on the welfare of the society as a whole. The NSS units of Guru Jambheshwar University of Science & Technology are involved in inculcating the feelings of empathy and self-extension among students. The units work with the objectives to uphold and promote the values of communal harmony, patriotism and National Integration among students as well as community members through various NSS activities. Seven days camps, State Level NSS Camp, National Integration camps are the integral part of the NSS. The NSS units have been actively involved in community service and organizing awareness programmes related to prevention of HIV/AIDS, female foeticide, drug addiction and cashless India etc. NSS volunteers are also involved in the activities related to women empowerment, literacy and personality development, plantation, cleanliness, pulse polio, blood donation, digital and cashless India etc.

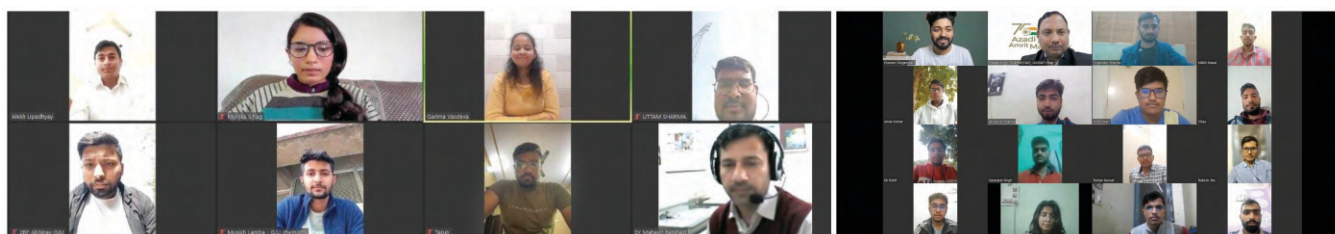

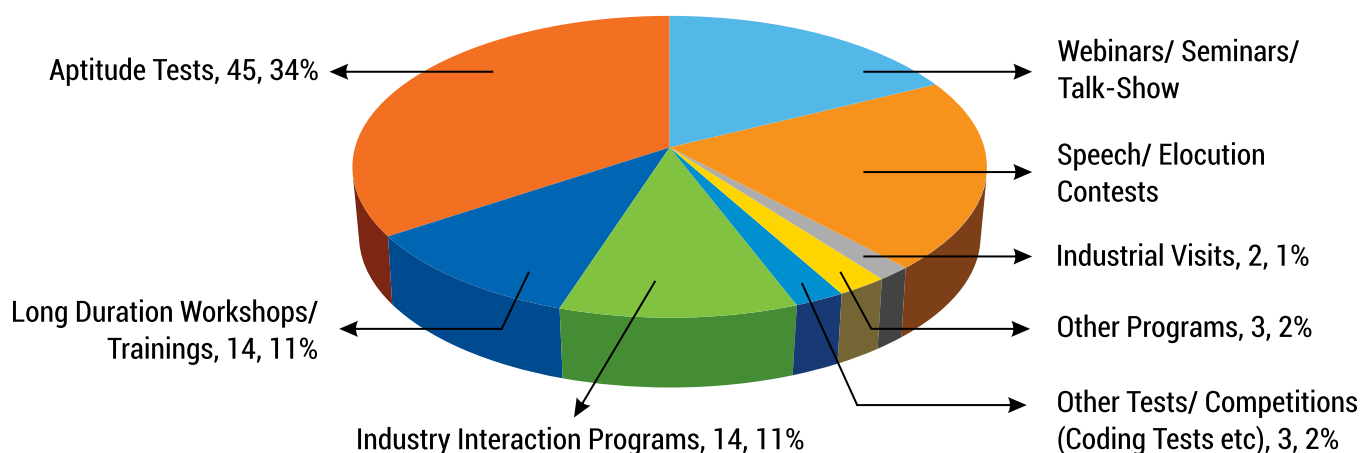

## Placement Process

- ❖ The Placement Session begins in the month of August and goes up till June of the following year.
- ❖ Invitations with the relevant information are sent to the various organizations by the T&P Cell.
- ❖ The details of the Jobs are made available online to the students along with other information furnished by the organization. Interested and eligible students (as per the criteria specified by the company) show their willingness to appear in the recruitment process of the organization by registering online with the Training and Placement Cell of the institute.
- ❖ The verified database along with the resumes of all such students is shared with the organization beforehand. During campus recruitment, conducting of pre placement talks, tests, GDs, personal interviews etc. are coordinated and managed by the Student Coordinators and the T&P Cell Team.
- ❖ At the end, the organization declares the list of the final offers either on-campus or through e-mail.
- ❖ The Training and Placement Cell also coordinates the signing of offer letters by the students who have been selected and also sends the confirmation of the acceptance to the companies for their kind reference.
